

## ENGLISH TRANSLATION OF THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF CHEMICALS HELPDESK

06.03.2026

### ISSUES RELATED TO THE CHEMICAL REGISTRATION PROCESS

Establishing the national chemicals inventory is of great importance. Within the scope of the work carried out by the Ministry to establish this chemicals inventory, companies are required to submit Individual Temporary Registrations for chemicals by **30 September 2026**, regardless of tonnage.

If some of the information required under Annex-1 of the Procedures and Principles cannot be obtained, the missing information may be documented with justification by the companies through the Chemicals Registration System of the Ministry, and temporary registration dossiers may be submitted. The missing information and documents may subsequently be updated through the Chemicals Registration System until the final registration deadlines specified in the Regulation.

After **30 September 2026**, inspections will be carried out regarding the temporary registration numbers for substances manufactured or imported by companies.

For substances that companies will newly manufacture or import after **30 September 2026**, companies must submit a temporary/full registration application before manufacture or import, obtain the registration numbers, and continue their activities accordingly.

Member companies of a substance for which a full registration dossier has previously been submitted by the Lead Registrant may also submit individual temporary registrations by documenting related justifications (such as disproportionate cost sharing, confidentiality concerns, or differences of opinion) through the Chemicals Registration System.

Companies that have already obtained a full registration number for a substance are not required to obtain a temporary registration number for the same substance.

If the necessary data cannot be obtained during the full registration process for substances that have been temporarily registered, an additional period of two years will be granted beyond the relevant deadlines.

During this period, it is planned to monitor the process through Chemicals Advisory Group meetings and manage the completion of the information and documents required for full registration.
